



## Fixit 475

Primer for mineral-based final renderings

**Areas of use:** Fixit 475 is an undercoat for mineral-based final renders which evens out the absorptive characteristics of the substrate. It improves the adhesion of the final render. The substrate must be clean, dry and of adequate load-bearing capacity.

**Composition:**

- Binding agent: potassium silicate, synthetic resin dispersion
- Aggregates: calcitic fillers
- Additives: pigments

**Basics:** The general rules of building construction must be observed, in addition to the current notes published by the «Swiss Association of Painters and Plasterers SMGV», the recommendation SIA 242 «Plaster and drywall work» and the information in this technical data sheet.

**Application procedure:** Fixit 475 is ready-to-use. Stir well before application, if necessary add water (max. 5 %) to give the required working consistency.

**Storage:** Shelf life at least 12 months if stored unopened in the original containers and protected from frost, heat and direct sunlight.

**Important note:** Do not apply when the air or substrate temperature is below +5 °C or above +30 °C. For uncoated finishing plasters, we recommend using the Fixit 475 coloured in the colour of the finishing plaster. Newly applied plaster must be allowed sufficient time to dry and for carbonation to complete.
